


G2211 Coding and Payment Policy Flowchart

Needs Ongoing Care

- Dementia
- Migraines
- Epilepsy
- Chronic inflammatory demyelinating polyneuropathy (CIDP)
- Multiple sclerosis
- Parkinson syndrome
- ALS
- Cerebral palsy



Does Not Need Ongoing Care

- Memory problems not requiring ongoing care
- Tension headache (due to stress, etc.)
- New onset seizure (if uncertain prognosis, not on daily medication)
- Acute Disseminated Encephalomyelitis (ADEM)
- Cerebral palsy (if not managing their tone)
